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The Law of Recognition

- 1. I believe God has shown me some defeat in certain areas of our lives. The reason maybe because, we may not understand the Laws that governs these areas.**
- 2. Recognize – Identify someone or something from an encounter. Hebrew – to know, to understand, to realize. Greek – To acknowledge, to admit, to come to know.**
- 3. Life is governed by Laws/Laws govern life. The Law of Promotion - teaches you can only be promoted, by someone whose instructions you have followed. Ps 75:6. The Law of Reproduction – indicates, you can only reproduce something you are. Gen 1:11-12. The Law of Seed - reveals whatever you give will create that in which you will receive. Gal 6:7, Gen 8:22 And the Law of Recognition teaches - Everything we need is already in our life, waiting for us to recognize it!**
- 4. There may be something we are not seeing in our lives today...and it could be costing us dearly. NOTE: God has and will continue to supply all our needs according to His riches and Glory in Christ Jesus. That means our needs are met. PERIOD. We may have not seen, secure or possessed it. However, if God says it, it's true and let every man be a liar, let God's Word be True.**
- 5. The Pharisees did not recognize the Divinity of Jesus. Luke 19:41-42,44. He was there, walking, talking, teaching, but they did recognize the Savior of the World.**
- 6. Spiritual people do not always understand the Law of Recognition, because I haven't always. And I personally believe that we have missed a ton of God's Blessings. I believed at times we have not recognized and appreciated the people/situations God has laid before us, as a direct Blessing from Him, for our lives.**
- 7. I will try, to assist us in recognizing a true movement of God in our lives, address the following topics, in the recent weeks and months to come, as I am allowed and instructed:**
 - How to Recognize the Voice of Holy Spirit.**
 - How to Recognize a True Man/Woman of God.**
 - How to Recognize Specific Anointing, i.e., Leadership, Administration, Psalmists, Prophetic, Healings etc....**
 - How to Recognize Those God has Assigned to our lives rather than the one we have assigned to us.**

- How to Recognize the Dominant Weakness of those we have chosen to Trust.
 - How would I know if our present Assignment is from God, or is it one we have chosen, which is why we are not happy in our Assignments. Happiness is doing the Will of God.
 - How to Recognize the Dominant Weakness in our Lives. That will eliminate pride.
 - How to Recognize a Fool.
 - Who is the Intercessor God Has assigned to our lives/Facts We Should Know About Intercessory
 - Recognition the Love God has for you.
 - And much, much more
8. The first topic we will address will be the **Holy Spirit**.
 9. The Holy Spirit is the Master Communicator and He is a Person. Nobody speaks as much as He does. Heb 11:3. The cry of Jesus was that the Church listen to the Spirit. Rev 2:7, 11, 17, 29.
 10. Jesus talks to the Father John 14:16; The Father talks to the Holy Spirit John 14:16; The Holy Spirit talks to us Rev 2:7. He also intercedes for us, according to the Will of God. Romans 8:26-27.
 11. Just a few rewards of recognizing, respecting, and honoring the Holy Spirit:
 - He Warns us of Danger/Tragedies/difficult people/situations and much, much, much more.
 - Helps avoid broken Marriages and Relationships/gives us wisdom with our Families, vocations, etc.
 - Unlock waves of Favor/Blessings/Brings Inner Peace/bring Prosperity/helps us to operate in love. etc..
 12. His desire is for us to listen to His voice (for our own benefit) before we make any commitments to men/women/children, of our time, money, significant changes in your Ministry. etc...
 13. His Works: He created us: Job 33:4; John 6:63. Wrote the Word: 2 Peter 1:21. He selects our gifts: 1 Cor 12. Assigns people to us: Acts 8:29. He Puts us where our Gifts will flourish, and where we will be celebrated, not tolerated. He births in us a supernatural love for those to whom we are assigned to: Rm 5:5. He is pleased by Singing and Worship: Zep 3:17. His Rules of Conduct are: Ps 100:2. He is easily offended: Ep 4:29-32. When He is offended: He withdraws His Presence. Hosea 5:15. Then Depression comes.
 14. Joy and pleasures forever more are proof that the Holy Spirit is Presence. Ps 16:11

How to Recognize those God has Assigned to Us and those we have assigned to ourselves, or Satan has assigned to us.

15. The second topic we will address tonight will be – Recognition of Those Assigned to us. This will assist us in identifying those, God has placed, we have placed, or Satan has placed, in our lives. – In this segment we will simultaneously refer to a variety of people who have access within our lives.
16. Case and point, if God wants to guide you, bless you, speak into your life, enlighten you, prosper you, etc.... He sends His people. If Satan wants to trick you, bring you down, gaslight you, steal your Anointing, sap your energy/inheritance, keep you confused, keep you always doubting, keep you angry, keep you fighting, he sends his people. God has assigned people to our lives, so has Satan. How would I know who is who?? Below are some signs.
17. God assigned people feel very protective toward you. They are willing to take on your battles. They want to be a wall of protection, a source of nourishment and a motivating force in your life. They can be your authority, friends, family, neighbors etc...
18. We absolutely cannot succeed alone and be normal. God never intended for us to live our life without relationships. John 6:68.
19. Mentors are assigned to impart to you. Elijah was assigned to Elisha. Paul felt the pain of Timothy. Moses advised Joshua. Mordecai to Esther. Proteges are assigned to learn from you. They will find nowhere else, what God has placed within you for them. And they know it.
20. Here are some Facts to Help Us Identify Those Assigned to Us by God:
 - Each person assigned to you will solve a different problem for you. They will not cause a bunch for you to solve. Some of these people will motivate you. Some will educate you. Some correct you.
 - Those really assigned to you by God, will proudly identify you in Public. The critics of Elijah mocked Elisha. Elisha told them to “Hold your Peace”. 2Kings 2:3.
 - Those assigned to you will gladly adjust their plans to assist you in times of need.
 - They feel protective toward you. Example: Peter/ear, John 18:10; Mk 14:47; Luke 22:50.
 - God’s appointed people will defend you in your absence. People should never feel they can speak negative about God (use His Name in Vain), the Pastor, the House, people you love etc. in front of you. Enemies should feel uncomfortable in attacking someone you genuinely love, while in your presence. Family???
 - These God assigned people will warn you of dangerous people/ situations, or impeding traps in love, at the expense potential harming the relationship. Acts 20:31

- Those who God has assigned to you will never enter a covenant of friendship, with anyone plotting your destruction or participate in the bringing down your reputation. Pro 17:17
- Those assigned to you willingly become enemies with your enemies. Esther/Haman Jews Esther 8
- Those assigned to you will protect your reputation at any cost. Ruth 3. She honored Boaz request.
- Those assigned will pay any price to please you, David/Water, 1 Chron 11:17-19.
- Those assigned to you Discern Your Greatness even when your behavior appears unwise. David/ Nabal. 1 Sam 25
- Your assigned will not discard you because of the flaws, they have seen in your life.
- Those assigned to you have flaws, which enables them to endure yours.
- Anyone who breaks your confidentiality, in a way to degrade you, is not assigned to you, by God.
- God assigned people may sometimes doubt you, as Thomas did Jesus, but they will not disrespect or exploit you. John 20
- They may even dread their assignment as Jonah did, but God will heal the situation, if He has assigned that person to you. Jonah 1
- They may sometimes disappoint you. Peter denied Jesus three times. Matt 26.
- They may be assigned to you for just a short season. Jesus/Samaritan Woman. One day changed her forever.
- They can often endure different stresses that you cannot.
- People assigned to you will never use the position God has placed them in, for their own agenda, (your authority, recourses, contacts, etc.) behind your back, without the courtesy of requesting permission or simply first running it by you. Elisha and Gehazi 2 Kings 5:20-27.
- They will not covet (desire, wish they had, lust) for your Anointings, Possessions, Positions, Family etc...

15. If we have been guilty of disrespecting or not appreciating these people God has so gracefully put into our lives, shall we take time to repent. Not appreciating these people is a sure sign, we will lose them. God will eventually turn their hearts to another. Shall we bless God and recognize those who have blessed our lives, been faithful to us, helped us, etc.... A special thanks to those who prayed to us through to the Holy Ghost. Gen 6:3

17. Stopping to recognize the Bless people who continue to serve us, who are still with us can remove unnecessary burdens and responsibilities, which make life seem unbearable at times. God has assigned them to Bless you!!
