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Revival By Fire

1. Revival is when God comes down in us.
2. God's desire is for all to be saved, Is 45:22, Hab3:2; Psalm 85:4-6 (NOTE: "Again" means they had been saved and revived, before).
3. Is 45:22. Before a Revival begins in others, it must begin in us. We must first allow the Lord to revive us, and then we bring everyone into this realm of Revival. This is what we really need.
4. Law is defined as rules which a particular country or community recognize as regulating the action of its members and which may be enforced by the imposition of penalties. A rule defining correct procedure or behavior. Sufficient in law; unobjectionable.
5. Eight Laws in Romans:
 - Law of Moses (2:12; 3:19; 7:12)
 - Law of Nature (2:14-15)
 - Law of Faith (3:27; 4:3-5, 11-24)
 - Law of the Mind (7:16, 21, 23)
 - Law of Sin (7:23, 25; 8:2)
 - Law of Righteous (9:31)
 - Law of God (7:22,25)
 - Law of the Spirit of Life, that is, the Holy Spirit of Life, that works through the redemption of Christ to make free from and to cancel the law of sin and death in all who are in Christ (8:2)
6. After a study of Nee, Spurgeon and Wigglesworth, I concluded The Law of Revival is a Law of Spiritual Life. **
7. Revival in the Church has been defined as Spiritual awakening and applies to one that has become cold in God, stumbles, goes back to the world, but if he comes back to God and continues to pursue God, he has experienced an awakening, a Revival. This is true.
8. However, this is not all the Bible defines as Revival. Even if a person does not stumble, grow cold or backslide, he still needs a Revival, because being revived is a Law of the Spiritual life. Revival is the metabolism (the chemical process that occurs with a living organism to maintain life) of our Spiritual Life. **
9. If we consider what the Bible says concerning us and Revival, we can see our lives include a "metabolic" process. This process is a cycle that is repeated continually. So, (the trial) the beginning, the course and the ending are a spiritual metabolism. This is the Law of Revival.
10. Every new beginning is a new Revival and is followed by a course and another ending.
11. We as individuals need to understand the Law of Revival and touch the secret to Revival, it will be so easy for us to experience Revival. We must be taught this Law. We have felt stagnant, oppressed, because we have not applied this law. After the Preacher left, we begin to fall back into the same.
12. More Revivals result in faster growth – but after the end of a Revival, it is not necessary to experience a prolonged period, according to the Law of Revival, every Revival has a course, after which there will be a sense of being unsatisfied. This prepares us for a new Revival. So, we should

not feel, oppressed, and defeated for a long time, because those feelings quickly indicate God is preparing another Revival in your life. Those feelings (in the course) indicate we need **a new supply** of God and Revival will come, to you from God, in the manifested area He is perfecting!!!!

13. Saints, this is according to this Law of Revival, genuine growth in life is gained by the cycle of being revived, feeling unsatisfied for a period, after the end of a revival, and being revived again.
14. Sadly, when this feeling comes, some saints, backslide, Church hop, etc...., they do not genuinely experience Revival or learn new things about God and His process!
15. Genuine spiritual growth depends on the renewing of the inner Person's life. The renewal of life is called Revival. The outside person is dying daily. (1 Cor 15:31)
16. As we experience Revival we will know and receive more spiritual things. After a period, the things and knowledge grow old, we become dissatisfied and weak. The element of self is discharged (slowly dying), and the element of God is added; we decrease, and He increases. It is only through this Revival cycle we can grow.
17. Knowing ourselves – In a pause, after the cycle of Revival, which is when we are not satisfied, we begin to see ourselves. This is also a law, we do not see ourselves in time of Revival, because we are like a person, drunk with wine. We are so excited and happy.
18. At the end of the Revival, things are clearer, we are again dissatisfied, low, our being is still, we become calm, we begin to see the weaknesses and short comings in our lives and the lives of others (Confusion in the Church, sin, Saints fighting, arguing, etc.). In Revival, we are high and will say or do anything for God!! No temper, no anger etc. The Revival covers our weakness but when it is over, real condition exist.
19. **KNOWING OURSELVES IN ORDER TO EXPERIENCE CHRIST AND HAVE A REVIVAL-** First, we feel our weaknesses are terrible (wrong). Jesus has broken death, has ascended, is exalted and is transcendent (above the range of normal or merely physical human experience; surpassing the ordinary; exceptional) over everything. When we begin to understand we are transcendent over everything, we enter a new Revival.
20. Revival is not a once and for all experience. Revival will come to an end, and we must be dissatisfied, then a new one begins.
21. Jesus is in the Work of making us into His image. First, we must know His Word, then we must know us and be honest with ourselves, so God can use this process to make us into His amazing image. We discover our weaknesses in a Revival.
22. **APPLYING THE LAW OF REVIVAL:** If we are skillful in the application of the Law of Revival, it will not be difficult for us to be revived if we apply the law. It would be unnecessary for us to be in a state of dissatisfaction or oppression for a long time.
23. The more we look at ourselves, the more incompetent we feel and the colder we become. We cannot rise unless we apply the Law of Revival. When we have faith in God and the Process, then we will experience another cycle of Revival.
24. We do not need to beg for Revival, only to know the Process. In this process, we will grow continually in the Lord and Savior!! Our stature in Jesus will grow; spiritual elements will increase within us and we will put off self. It is only through this law, will we grow and advance.
25. A natural revival includes, Eating, drinking and sleeping it's a natural law. After sleeping we are restored, eat breakfast restored, lunch/nap/rest, restored, dinner restored. It restores us. It's reviving the Body. Same in the spiritual, we expend spiritual energy every day and in every way. Remember: The Law of Revival, the Beginning, Course and Ending. Same in the Natural. As this cycle is continuous, we are continually revived. After the ending we need another Revival.
26. As we mature in Christ, we will experience daily Revivals. We will eat Him/His Word when we are hungry (down, oppressed etc.). That will keep us during or after the Process or whenever we need Him.
27. If we touch the Lord when we are dry, we will always be refreshed and experience Revival.
28. Examples:
 - Every Spring is a Revival/365 day every day is small cycle/then winter.
 - Every morning is a small beginning, a small revival, 3 meals, 3 small revivals.

- **Salvation for us, Big Revival; Forsook our Past and gave ourselves to God, Big Revival; Raise from Death into Life, Big Revival.**
29. **When we begin to lose the thunder of being saved and all the Blessings that are flowing and the things we have learned, it's time for a Revival to deliver us from living in our feelings and help us live by Faith.**
 30. **Example: A death, a debt, a family situation, etc.... if we are applying the Law of Revival, we immediately know that is a sign urging us to turn to our Lord, look at Him, experience Him and gain Him. As soon as we experience Jesus in this way, we will be uplifted. This is a small revival. We can experience several Revivals many times a day.**
 31. **KNOWING THE LAW OF REVIVAL ENABLES US TO BE REVIVED EASILY- 2 Cor 12:10, Apostle Paul says, I am well pleased in weakness, then I am strong. When we know the Law of Revival, even in pain, we can rejoice that God is the God of Revival.**
 32. **Proper Spiritual living involves the law of Revival, the cycle of Revival. The more we are revived, the more we will be refreshed, living, strong, open and mature.**
 33. **NEEDING TO KNOW AND APPLY THE LAW OF REVIVAL – Sometimes we sense a need for Revival, even though our Spiritual life is advancing smoothly. However, the Holy Spirit directed by God, creates certain situations in our environment to force us to seek the Lord for Revival. We might be troubled by Family, work, etc..... These are all signs we need a Revival. Matt 11:28.**
 34. **But know, it is not merely handing problems to God but, it is experiencing the Law, helping us to be delivered from self, and the more Jesus in us will increase. This is a crucial Law. True joy depends on our knowledge and application of the Law of Revival.**
 35. **NOTE: Convenience is an enemy to Revival.**

Revival That will Bring the Lord Back

- 1. Watchman Nee fasted every Saturday, all day. Everywhere children were seen reading their Bible in School, praying together. Young people were raised up and became leaders in the Church.**
- 2. Nee was not able to do Ministry for six years 42-48, because of rebelliousness in Shanghai. The Revival in latter 1948, nearly all the rebellious and dissenting ones came back and repented.**
- 3. The Lord desires that we be revived and that we bring this Revival to every place.**
- 4. Loving the Lord in a fresh and new way always indicates Revival. Praying the Prayer, "Lord, I love you so much, I want you afresh and new" indicates that we have a heart to be revived.**
- 5. If we practice what is revealed Ephesians 4:11-16, we will spontaneously have a true/great revival in us! We will enjoy the infilling of the Holy Spirit spontaneously. We will have peace, joy, and the sweet sense of the Lord's Presence all day long. We will be revived, and we will live in Revival.**
- 6. Per Nee, Wigglesworth, and Spurgeon, Revival takes praying and fasting, day and night.**
- 7. Attending Services meetings, not merely to listen, but rather to speak something of the Lord and for the Lord to someone else, will bring joy and have a sense of the Lord's Presence.**
- 8. Every day we awake, should be a prayer for Revival for ourselves and others. Praying a prayer, "Lord, I heard a Word from you, we need Revival" and apply the Law of Revival!**
- 9. When Real Revival comes in us, we are revived and bear fruit.**
- 10. We have learned that traditional Revival is not reliable but comes and goes quickly. The Process does not need it.**
- 11. The Prevailing Revival in Wales in 1904 lasted only one year. Evangelists Revival do not last long. We need a daily Revival.**
- 12. Later, when the Revival came, the Saints offered up everything they had, gave up their material possessions, to the extent that this kind of consecration went from morning until midnight. Even the offering boxes were too small to take care of the offerings.**
- 13. All the problems that come upon us to destroy the outer man, but our inner man to be renewed day by day. This is Revival.**
- 14. The Holy Spirit works within us for our renewing, and the decaying of our outer man through the environment is also for our renewing. This renewing is a Revival.**
- 15. One law from man's physical life is the human body needs a revival every morning.**
- 16. Fifty minutes praying and reading the Word, will constitute a daily Revival.**
- 17. When Jesus is really the Head of any Church, in His rightful position and in authority in any Church, that Church will be in Revival.**
- 18. If we let Jesus, have full reign and preeminence and reign in and on me, I will become the Holy Mountain of God, being fully in a condition of knowing God in Revival and in harmony; I will be full of light and life. The whole issue hinges on Christ's position of authority!**
- 19. Spiritual Birth is not a quick Revival but is the result of constant growth. The work must be done in us!!**
- 20. Prayer: Father, in the Name of Jesus, I circumcise myself today as I take away everything that has stood between my heart and You, thus straining our relationship. I repent of all evil doing of my heart and hands, In the Name of Jesus. Jeremiah 4:22. God: For my people is foolish, they have none understanding; they are wise to do evil, but to do good, they have no knowledge. Me: Father rid me of every foolishness that makes my own ways as wisdom in my eyes that I may see my true state before you and amend my ways. Father, have mercy on WOFC and the Body of Christ as a whole, for having a rebellious and revolting heart toward you in doing what seemed good in our own eyes, rather than letting the Holy Spirit lead His Church. Have Mercy upon us and cleanse us, that we may reunite with you, In Jesus Name!!!**
- 21. Jer 5:26a Father, rid the Congregation of wicked people who lure and sow seeds of discord and carnality amongst the brethren and thereby polluting Your House and Your Children, that we will walk in unity and purpose pursue after You. Let the boldness You once put in me rise and declare You, Lord in Jesus Name.**

22. Steps for Preparation for Revival:

- **Enter a renewed commitment with God, to holiness (separate for worldliness, in which no man should see the Lord) and obedience. Heb 12:14**
- **Stay Expectant: Expect Revival in you and that God gives you a person to revive. Be accountable to someone of your Ministering/Witnessing, weekly.**
- **Confess, Engage in Evangelism. Join Ministries, talk with Soul winners. Pray for Revival in the Kingdom, daily.**
- **Promote Unity Ps 133:1,3.**
